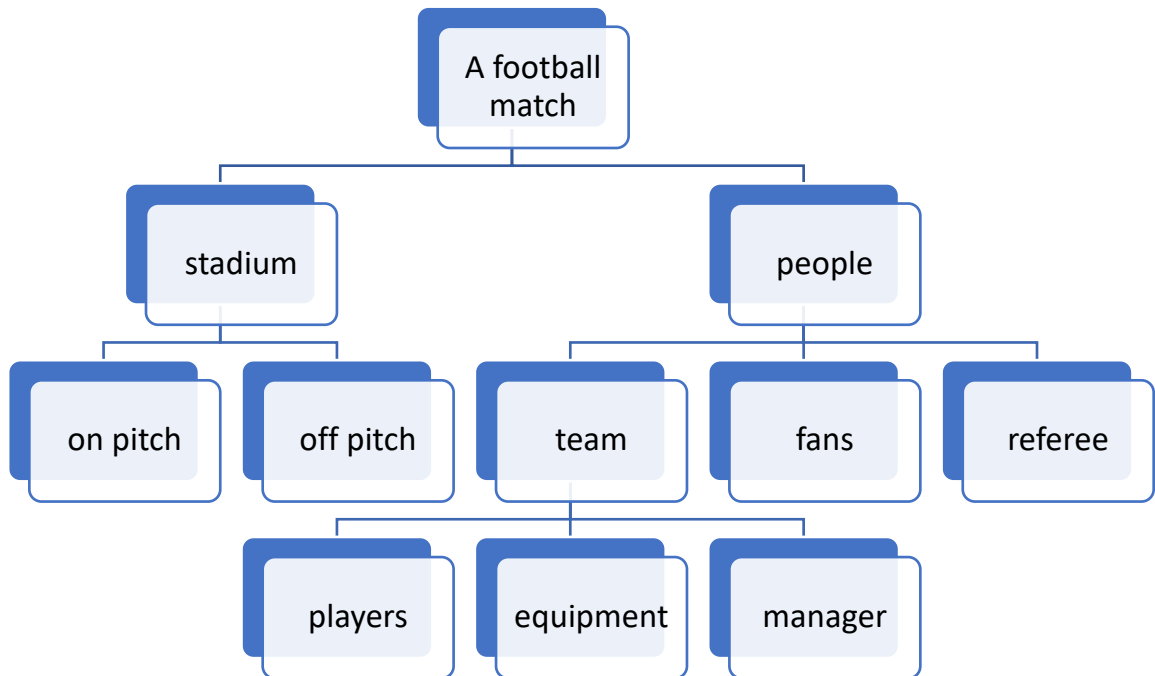


**Flipped Vocabulary**

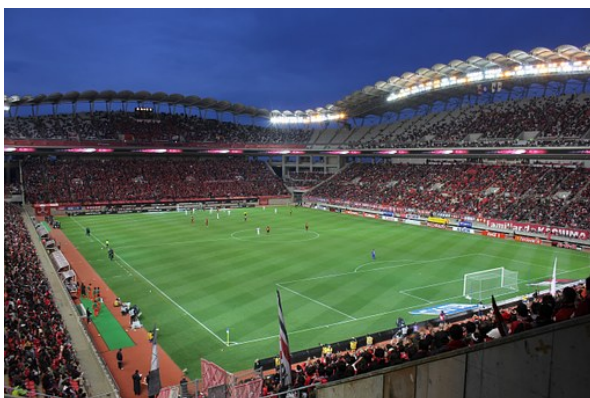
1. Read through the list of words in the box and check their meaning if necessary.
